# Simple as this, your rams won't live inside, so why should ours?

Here at Kiandra Poll Merino, we try to put as much selection pressure on our sale rams as possible. This means your investment in merino rams and the lambs bred won't let you down.

By running the sale rams outside, in a commercial environment, it allows us to select for feet and pasterns, dags and scours, weather proof wool and feed conversion. By doing this we are able to provide a ram with genetics to reduce management, therefore improve profit.

Over the last couple of years the team at Kiandra have been putting in the hard yards to improve the amount of pedigree that is recorded on sale rams and retained ewes. This will only increase in the future, they have also been strategically using genomics to help improve the accuracy of their own selection decisions and the information they can supply on sale rams. This gives us a lot of confidence that the rams will breed like the numbers say they will. Remember, using breeding values is like being able to predict the future - they are that powerful. Importantly, no amount of feeding or shedding will change the DNA. The genes they are born with are the genes they will pass on to their progeny and an ASBV is the only way of knowing what these genes are.
